General Responsibility:

The Chapel Coordinator/Worship Leader is responsible for organizing everything involved with our evening chapels: all media, music, and activities. Also, working together with our weekly speaker in meeting any specific needs or wants.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. To work alongside all other staff living in Christian Community that creates lasting relationships.
2. Prepare media needed for chapel.
3. Having high energy, kindness, and patience at all times with campers and the worship band.
4. Work at constantly improving the media at Cooperstown Bible Camp.
5. Follow all CBC standards, and agree with the EFCA statement of faith.
6. Represent the camp and its purpose in a positive manner when you are in public.
7. Possess an attitude and actions which continually reflect that Christ lives in you.
8. Review all media for inconsistencies and inappropriate material.
9. Create the weeks slideshow.
10. Assist counselors by being a "Cabin Buddy" as needed.
11. Be a leader and direct the worship band.
12. Look to better the overall worship experience.
13. Help with taking photos throughout the week.

- Ability to stay focused and be self-motivated.
- Create a welcoming and open environment for all campers, guests, and other staff members.
- Ability to work independently when needed and be a team player.
